



DESCRIPTION

The term icon is derived from the Greek word eikon, which translates to image. Icons are religious panels depicting Christ the Savior, the Virgin Mary, and a host of other biblical figures and are widely found amongst Eastern Churches. Icons are commonly venerated along with saints.

This particular icon is known as the 'Inexhaustible Cup', which depicts both Mary and Jesus blessing the communion Chalice. Communion is the practice through which Christians receive the blessings given to them by Christ and the chalice serves the purpose of transferring those blessings unto them. Mary's hands are raised upwards, which represent her offering her Son as a sacrifice to God.
