The term icon is derived from the Greek word eikon, which translates to image. Icons are religious panels depicting Christ the Savior, the Virgin Mary, and a host of other biblical figures and are widely found amongst Eastern Churches. Icons are commonly venerated along with saints.

Wilhelm von Kaulbach was a German painter known for his murals. His painting "Guardian Angel" depicts an angel embracing a child while soaring above a landscape whose only feature is a church. The somber landscape compliments the solemn visages of both characters.
