The term icon is derived from the Greek word eikon, which translates to image. Icons are religious panels depicting Christ the Savior, the Virgin Mary, and a host of other biblical figures and are widely found amongst Eastern Churches. Icons are commonly venerated along with saints.

Mary and Jesus are embracing one another, while Mary is also presenting him to the world. This particular art form is most commonly found amongst Greek Orthodox icons. The three stars located on Mary represent her eternal virginity and reinforces her as the Virgin Mother.
