



DESCRIPTION

The term icon is derived from the Greek word eikon, which translates to image. Icons are religious panels depicting Christ the Savior, the Virgin Mary, and a host of other biblical figures and are widely found amongst Eastern Churches. Icons are commonly venerated along with saints.

Christ is depicted here with his crown of thorns, looking upwards towards Heaven. This iconography in particular is not Eastern in nature due to the depiction of the suffering of Christ. Eastern Christian churches tend to depict Christ at peace.
