



DESCRIPTION

The term icon is derived from the Greek word eikon, which translates to image. Icons are religious panels depicting Christ the Savior, the Virgin Mary, and a host of other biblical figures and are widely found amongst Eastern Churches. Icons are commonly venerated along with saints.

It is commonplace in Eastern iconography to have the images depicted facing forward. Mary's hand is motioning towards Jesus and presenting him to the world. The halos encircling their bodies represent the heavenly status confirmed to them.
