

DESCRIPTION

Triple spouted pots like this are found commonly throughout tribes in East and Central Africa. Double spouts signify the birth and wellbeing of twins, but this varies greatly throughout all of Africa. The design is concentrated between the lip of the pot and the base of the neck. Two smaller spouts are found to either side of the larger ones, and are highly structural in nature. While most likely used to hold water, this vessel may have served some sort of ritual purpose.
