Vessels were typically created of ancestors in order for their descendants to communicate with them. These vessels serve as a medium for communicating with those in the afterlife. The studded body design is common in many cultures pottery usage. It contrasts greatly with the smoother features of the visage itself. Purely decorative in nature and function, this piece beautifully depicts the skill and talent of the artisan that crafted it.
