



DESCRIPTION

Born and raised in The Eastern Cape of South Africa, Ian Garrett became enthralled with ceramics from an early age.

Few artisans have mastered and accomplished what Garrett has in the field of ceramics. The way in which he combines complex textured patterns with a balanced and polished surface attest to the immense amount of detail placed into each individual piece. Artist Eugene Hon comments "Maintaining these skills and level of perfection is what separates Ian Garrett from the rest."

This vessel in particular acknowledges the work of traditional Zulu potters that are found throughout South Africa in a simple yet timeless beer pot. Ian's work itself is on another plane compared to a vast number of other ceramic artists. The surface itself is free from any irregularities, which requires maintaining a constant temperature throughout the firing process. The glaze and raised details speak volumes about the meticulous means in which they were created.
